Currently on OPT? Regulations of your visa still REQUIRE you to:

- Report any change in mailing/residential address
- Report any change to your name
- Report any change to your visa
- Report any change in your employment (different job? new location? quit your job? fired?)
- Confirm your name, address, employer, and employer's address every 6 months and 12 months
- You must report any updates within 10 days of the change
