Fall 2024 Enrollment Update (Prior To Census)

- Enrollment is down 3.0% 🖊
- Undergraduate enrollment is up 2.9% or 197 students
- Graduate enrollment is down 15.2% or 522 students
- Professional enrollment is down 2.0% or 33 students
- SCH is down 0.8% or 1207.5 credit hours 🖊




Fall 2024 Enrollment Update (Prior To Census)

- New Enrollment is down 3.0% 🦊
- First-Time College is up 4.2% resulting in another record class!
- Transfer Enrollment is up 0.2%
- New Graduate enrollment is down 22.8%

Fall 2024 Enrollment by African American, Hispanic and Multiple Race and International Ethnicity Overview

- African American Enrollment is up 2.4% and up 13% for First-Time College
- Hispanic Enrollment is up 11.4% and up 25% for First-Time College
- Multiple Race/Ethnicity Enrollment is up 5% and up 18.5% for First-Time
 College
- International Enrollment is down 25%, but up 48% for TRN

The **Enrollment Cliff** is predicted to begin to impact our region after Fall 2026.


The **Adult Learner Population** remains a market we need to continue to focus on to help with the downward turn in high school students.





4-Yr Projected Change in High School Graduates


Public and Non-public, 2021-22 to 2026-27
