

Living the Values Staff Award

Description

The Living the Values Award recognizes a staff employee that best exemplifies excellence in one or more of the University's key values: Learning, Diversity, Integrity, Accountability, Respect and Collaboration. Nominees must have shown extraordinary adoption of one or more of the key values in a work-related situation.

Eligibility

Nominee must be a benefit eligible staff employee at UMKC for at least one year by the nomination deadline and be in good standing. Nominee must be employed by the awarding College, School, or Division. Employees who have previously received the award are not eligible for nomination. All nominees will be reviewed by Human Resources to ensure they are in good standing with UM Policy.

Nature of Award

Commemorative Keepsake Award

• Terms of award: 1 award per CSD grouping. Previous award recipients are ineligible for repeat awards.

Nomination Process

Candidates are nominated by Faculty and/or Staff from their respective College, School, or Division. Send completed nominations to respective unit contact.

A completed nomination will include:

- Completed Coversheet
- 3 letters of recommendation, each not to exceed one page in length

Process may vary by unit, please reach out to your unit contact for guidance

Deadline for Submission of Nomination Materials **varies based on unit** (please refer to Unit Breakdown and contact list for more information – visit https://www.umkc.edu/hr/current-employees/staff-awards.html).

Selection Process

A nominations committee, appointed by unit leadership (Dean, Vice-Chancellor, etc.), will review all nominations and select the most qualified candidate based upon the qualifying criteria identified above.

Award Recipient will be recognized at the Annual University Staff Awards Ceremony on March 18, 2025.
