0365 Updates

IMPLEMENTED



Strict enforcement of email quotas – 25GB



User removal of highly sensitive data (DCL4) from their email accounts in a reasonable timeframe (10 days)



36,000 former student accounts have been deprovisioned or are in the process of being deprovisioned.



Data Loss Prevention (DLP) enabled for all accounts on 9/30.

IN-PROGRESS

Auto deletion of emails – expected implementation end of calendar year.

- In inboxes and sent items folders after 5 years

- In “deleted items” after 30 days

- Any email moved to a subfolder will be untouched

- Delayed due to outstanding bug in implementation. Case open with Microsoft.

IN-PROGRESS

More prompt deactivation and deletion of accounts post employment and enrollment.

- Current retiree accounts are grandfathered

- Future retirees can submit a request to maintain their email account

- Current ETA of this summer



UM-AD Migration

All users migrated to UM-AD domain



Migration of over 800 group policies



36,000 former student accounts have been deprovisioned

IN-PROGRESS

Workstation object migration

Over 5,000 computer objects to be migrated to UM-AD

All computer labs and ILE already moved

NEXT STEPS

- Cloud Storage Review committee formed with representation from IS leadership, technical experts, Faculty and Staff
- Identified 16 unique use cases and 37 features of importance to UMKC stakeholders
- Recommendation likely to include 2 preferred cloud providers and recommended use cases

- Review collaborated files and shared links, including any external links.

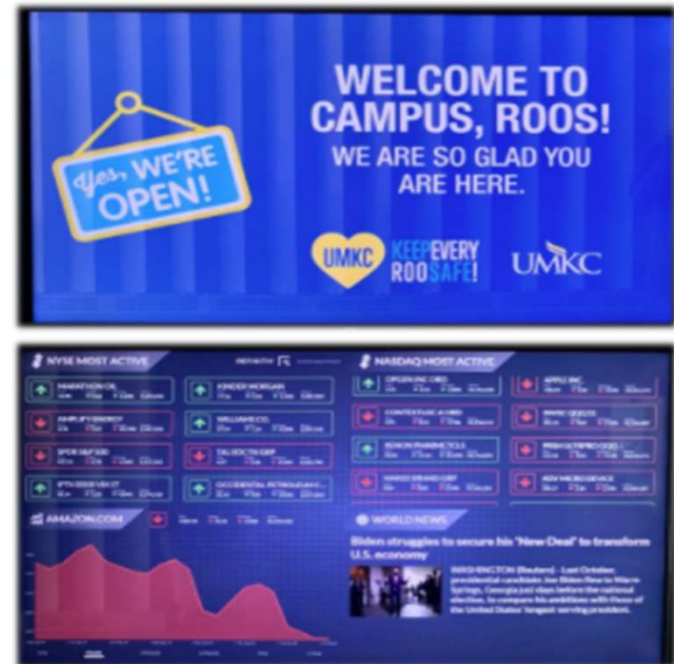




Digital Signage

Security Cameras

Information Services has taken over the management of campus security cameras (452 in total).

- All recordings are now able to be stored on central storage allowing for HD recordings and future growth
- New software platform to monitor cameras (Qognify VMS) implemented
- New funding model, \$11 monthly per camera to cover licensing and storage costs starting in FY23
- Planned upgrade of old and outdated cameras across campus





Technology Support Center – Future location

- Primary location of the TSC to move from 4825 Troost to Cherry Street Garage Mailroom and Foundation Call Center
- Improve the level of service we can provide to students, faculty, and staff by further supporting walk in technical support
- Central location will provide a more convenient location for drop in questions from Students, Faculty, and Staff
- Mailroom designed with direct dock access, providing a more streamlined and secure way to take deliveries.

RSMART ONE CAMPUS PORTAL

- Unified portal to connect students to online resources
- Currently in procurement process
- Will be used by Columbia, MS&T, and UMKC

GOOGLE LICENSING

- Google Workspace for Education Plus purchased for UM System
- Includes additional features, security tools, and applications
- Project starting soon to assign licenses, perform full suite review, and develop UM communications related to the same.





Zoom Authentication Changes – Coming Soon

EFFECTIVE MAY 18TH

- How you login to Zoom will be changing
- Same look and feel as logging into Email, PeopleSoft, Canvas
- No changes to meetings, settings, URLs, etc.
- Will require Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)
- Active project to identify any resource accounts using Zoom as these need additional information to ensure uninterrupted service

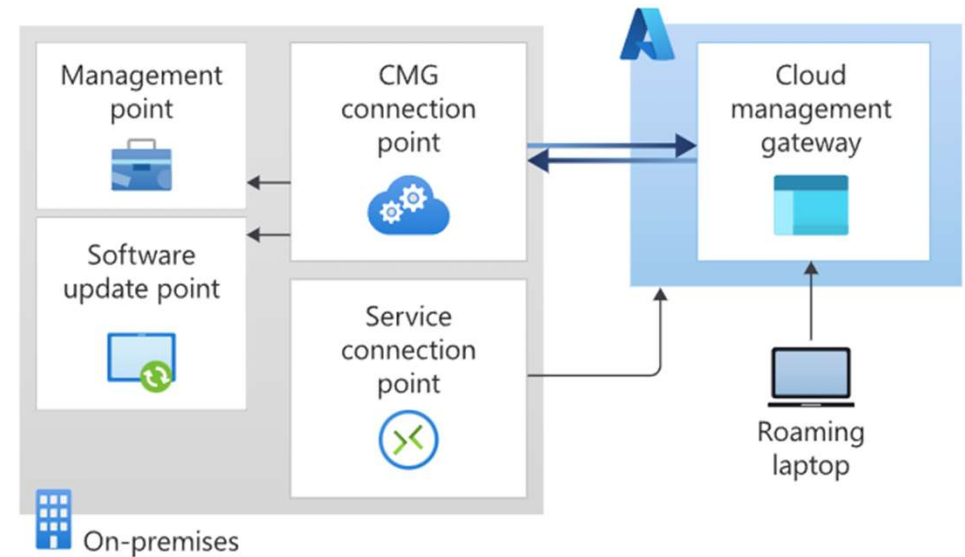




Azure AD Cloud Deployments

CLOUD MANAGEMENT GATEWAY (CMG)

- CMG allows us to deploy applications and updates for Windows workstations directly from Azure's Cloud
- Increased speed to deploy updates to UMKC workstations, regardless of location, home or on campus
- Currently used for critical application updates, such as VPN, Zoom, and Jabber but will be expanded upon over time

- Planned renovation of following labs this summer (102 total)
 - ▷ Cherry Hall Lab (24 High End All-in-One Workstations)
 - ▷ Bloch Heritage Hall lab (32 Standard Laptops)
 - ▷ Bloch Executive Finance lab (16 Laptops)
 - ▷ Hospital Hill 3304 Lab (30 All-in-One Workstations)
- Large Format Printer for Student Use located in MNL
 - ▷ Installation scheduled for first summer intersession
- Decommissioned the following labs due to lack of funding and use (134)
 - ▷ MNL 4th Floor - ILC (102 Workstations)
 - ▷ Environmental Sciences Lab Flarsheim 403 (18 Workstations)
 - ▷ Economics Lab (14 Workstations) – scheduled for summer



Workstation Replacement

PROGRAM INFO

- Workstation Replacement Program largest in several years
 - 636 workstations ordered
- Significant number of non-WRP equipment ordered in the last couple months
- As of last week, all equipment has arrived, and deployments are ongoing
- Working with Campus Leadership and Finance on expanding WRP to a more complete funding model as well as potentially covering research workstations.





Networking Update

New Projects

- ▽ Plaster data room fire suppression system conversion
- ▽ Centralized UPS for building telecom rooms
- ▽ Alternate fiber path to Hospital Hill
- ▽ Newcomb Hall data center HVAC upgrades

Redesigned Dental School Operator & New Patient phone queues

- ▽ Adds flexibility to add users to manage call volume

Added 3rd Cisco Call Manager virtual VoIP PBX

- ▽ Improve load balancing for the campus phone system

Completed Bloch Heritage Hall and Bloch Patio network design work

- ▽ Hardware on order

Piloting self-directed guest wireless at the Dental School

- ▽ Wi-Fi access through a web portal. "Panera Model"
- ▽ More restricted than UMKC-Wireless account shared accounts & rotating password

Replacing DC power rectifier & batteries at Medicine

- ▽ This systems powers the Med School Optical Node
- ▽ Hosts 100G uplinks to MOREnet and Hospital Hill uplinks to the campus network.
