UMKC Police

- P.O. Phillip Murphy gives presentation
- Address: 5005 Oak Street, **Ph: (816) 235-1515** (Murphy recommends we all program into phone)
- UMKC Police staffed 24hrs a day. State certified police officers. Crisis intervention certified officers (C.I.T.).
- Patrol unit—patrol Hospital Hill and Volker campuses (vehicle and foot patrol),
 Murphy encourages staff to say "hello" when possible—POs will generally not
 engage unprompted on the assumption staff/faculty may be working/otherwise
 busy. Respond to all calls for service, personal safety escorts (for those working
 late or similar, call officers if you feel uncomfortable walking to your car),
 motorist assistance (jump starts, unlocks)
- Community engagement unit—property registration (electronics, bicycles & instruments). Register your stuff using the form linked here:
 https://www.umkc.edu/police/forms-and-resources/ -- Forms=>Property
 Registration Form. Simple theft does happen on campus, so keep your stuff with you or secured. If property is registered, serial numbers are already in UMKC police system, which allows better tracking. In short, it's a good idea to register your things with UMKC police. Active shooter presentations, orientations, safety, etc also available
- Personal Safety on Campus: be aware of your surroundings and walk confidently.
 - -use the buddy system
 - -walk in well-lit areas
 - -have your keys in your hand
 - -trust your instincts
 - -if you think you're being followed, cross the street
 - -report ALL suspicious activity



- Building Safety on Campus
 - -keep office doors locked at all times
 - -keep windows secured
 - -report defective locks/doors to appropriate staff. This is important. Word of doors that don't lock gets around, which can be a safety concern.
 - -make sure your key ring does not identify you or your office location
 - -do not let strangers follow you into your building, parking garage, or room
 - -know your building evacuation plan
 - -report ALL suspicious activity in your building or area
- Vehicle Safety on Campus
 - -always be aware of your surroundings
 - -always keep your vehicle secure, with valuables our of sight
 - -try to park in well-lit, secured areas
 - -consider alarm systems
 - -if you think somebody is following you, go to a public place
 - -report ALL suspicious activity
- Steering Wheel Locks Available from UMKC Police or Dealerships
 - -Kia and Hyundai are particularly susceptible to theft (Murphy shows long list of models and years produced)
- Communications:
 - -police station lobby (5005 Oak Street)
 - -cell phone: 911 will go to City of Kansas City (KCPD Dispatch). If you dial 911, remember to state that you are on UMKC campus. KC wait times can be very long. If possible, contact UMKC police directly (816) 235-1515.
 - -emergency blue phones
 - -UMKC ALERT System (text email phone call)
 - -Rave Guardian App (https://www.umkc.edu/police/forms-and-resources/rave-guardian.html): download from App store. Use UMKC SSO to log in.
 - -safety timers (use to track location or set check in times)
 - -UMKC police phone number pre-configured for calls with GPS coordinates
 - -direct text messaging with UMKC police dispatchers ("Submit Tip"

button). You can text if you don't think it's feasible to make a phone call. Photos can also be sent. Texting will also include your location.

- -if your Rave Guardian app shows the wrong location for you, let the UMKC police know so that they can submit a support ticket with the app to get it sorted out
- -to register vehicles go to UMKC police Forms section
